**CHAIRMAN OF SUGA ATTENDS THE WORLD ELECTRONICS FORUM 2017  
ON BEHALF OF THE HONG KONG ELECTRONIC INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION**

During the conference, Dr. C. H. Ng, Chairman of SUGA delivered a speech in the role of Chairman of Hong Kong Electronic Industries Association on behalf of Asian countries. He promoted the ecological environment and development advantages for innovative technologies available in Hong Kong and interviewed by a French newspaper *Le Courrier* to discuss the feasibility and means of strengthening incubation of startup business in Hong Kong by taking reference from France’s experience.

**Dr. C. H. Ng, Chairman of SUGA and Chairman of The Hong Kong Electronic Industries Association**, said, “I am highly honoured to attend such a prominent industry event on behalf of Hong Kong. SUGA’s self-developed smart pet product series PETBLE® is a good example, showing how our development direction aligns with that of the world’s leading enterprises. Looking ahead, I will continue to strive diligently on behalf of the electronics industry aiming to attain better unity and closer cooperation, so as to create favourable conditions for the long-term development of the industry and to lead to more business opportunities.”
